What kinds of animals need care?

- * Shelter cats who need more room to run around and play.

How long do animals stay in foster care?

- * On average, kittens spend 4 weeks in a foster.
- * The time for each animal varies depending on their needs.
- * We discuss each case with potential fosters to make sure it is a good fit.

- * Fosters also provide food, litter, and other supplies.
- * We provide medical care.
