### What kinds of animals need care?

- \* Kittens under 2 months old.
- \* Mom cats with nursing kittens.
- \* Cats with medical conditions or injuries.
- \* Special needs cats.
- \* Shelter cats who need more room to run around and play.



# Can I foster if I have pets of my own?

- \* Yes! We welcome pet parents as fosters.
- \* The risk to your own pets is minimal if they are vaccinated and in good health.



## How long do animals stay in foster care?
